IGETC CERTIFICATION

1. IGETC Certification requires completion of the entire pattern prior to transfer. Upon completion, the student must request certification. Petitions are available in the Admissions & Records Office.
2. All IGETC courses must be completed with a grade of C or better.
3. UC transfers need not complete the Oral Communication requirement (Area 1, Group C).
4. CSU transfers need not complete the Language Other than English requirement.
5. It is recommended that CSU transfers complete the U.S. History, Constitution and American Ideals requirement prior to transfer.
6. Completion of the IGETC is not a requirement for transfer to a CSU or UC, nor is it the only way to fulfill the lower-division, general education requirements of the CSU or UC prior to transfer. Students may find it advantageous to take courses fulfilling CSU's general education requirements or those of a particular UC campus.

IGETC ADVISEMENT

UCLA advises the completion of IGETC for all majors.

IGETC **is not appropriate** for students planning to transfer to the following majors and to attend the following Universities:

- UC Berkeley:• Colleges of Chemistry, Engineering, Environmental Design, Natural Resources and the Haas School of Business
- UC Davis: College of Engineering
- UC Riverside: College of Engineering
- UC San Diego: Revelle or Roosevelt Colleges, students under TAG contracts, and the Division of Engineering
- UC Santa Barbara: College of Engineering

IGETC **is not recommended** for students planning to transfer to the following majors and attend the following Universities:

- UC Berkeley:• School of Optometry and Majors in Biological Sciences and Physical Sciences and Psychology.
- UC Davis:• B.S. Degrees in the College of Agricultural & Environmental Sciences, Letters & Sciences, and the Division of Biological Science
- UC Irvine: School of Engineering, Biological Sciences and Physical Sciences
- UC Riverside: College of Natural & Agricultural Sciences and College of Engineering
- UC Santa Barbara:• College of Creative Studies, and Majors in Biological Sciences, Biopsychology, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Geology and Geophysics
